Subject: **Impact Fee Updates**

On September 13, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners adopted an ordinance to amend Article 13 – Impact Fees of the Unified Land Development Code. The approved changes go into effect 12:01 am, January 1, 2026.

All impact fee assessments and collections are calculated utilizing the impact fee schedules effective on the permit issuance date. Impact fees will no longer be assessed based upon the application date.

New Impact Fee Schedules:

New Fee Rates:

All Impact Fee components will change. Impact fee increases are phased in over two or four year periods. This process began January 1, 2023 and will continue on January 1, 2024, January 1, 2025, and January 1, 2026.

Notice:

Print and display the **Notice of Impact Fee Increase** in areas frequented by applicants and the development community. The notice is located on the Impact Fee website under ***Fee Schedule and Information***.

Procedures for All Municipal Assessments:

The building permit issuance date will determine the impact fee schedule used, and the fees will be based upon the rates in effect at the time of permit issuance.

To The Building Community:

Effective January 1, 2026, at 12:01 A.M. Palm Beach County Impact Fees will change. Please also be advised that new impact fee schedules will be published and become effective on January 1st for each of the next two years.
